RESOLUTION NO. 2026-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF); ADOPTING THE WASTEWATER FACILITIES PLAN FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes provide for loans to local government agencies to finance the construction of wastewater facilities; and Florida Administrative Code requires the formal authorization by City Council to formally adopt a Facilities Plan outlining necessary wastewater facility improvements to comply with State of Florida funding requirements;

WHEREAS, formal adoption of the proposed Wastewater Facilities Plan is required for the City of Webster to participate in the State Revolving Loan Fund Program;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Webster, Florida agrees with the findings and summary of necessary wastewater system improvements as outlined in the Facilities Plan for the purpose of addressing system deficiencies, improving reliability, and supporting long-term wastewater service needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, FLORIDA THAT IT HEREBY FORMALLY APPROVES AND ADOPTS THE CITY OF WEBSTER WASTEWATER FACILITIES PLAN AS WRITTEN AND PRESENTED TO THE CITY COUNCIL ON THIS DATE:

SECTION I. The foregoing findings are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

SECTION II. The City of Webster, Florida, is authorized to approve the proposed Facilities Plan.

SECTION III. The Mayor is hereby designated as the authorized representative to provide the assurances and commitments that will be required by the Facilities Plan.

SECTION IV. The Mayor is hereby designated as the authorized representative to execute the Facilities Plan which will become the foundation of all activities related to wastewater system improvements. The Mayor is authorized to represent the City in carrying out the City's responsibilities under the Facilities Plan. The Mayor is authorized to delegate responsibility to appropriate City Staff to carry out technical, financial, and administrative activities associated with the Facilities Plan.

SECTION V. The legal authority for adoption of this Facilities Plan is pursuant to the City Charter, City Code of Ordinances, and the Laws of the State of Florida.

SECTION VI. Conflicts. All Resolutions or part of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII. Severability. If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to be invalidated or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION VIII. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval and adoption by the City Council.
